Hey luminary, it's Leslie Tagorda And I wanted to pop in for a short episode about this Capricorn Full Moon. In this episode, I wanted to share with you some of the ways that you can choose to work with this Capricorn Full Moon, and how to dismantle Capricorn. Because Capricorn is that systemic energy that we all feel how you dismantle it for change in your work, I wanted to offer you some personalized formula and reflections based on your rising sign. Then I'll be answering a few questions that the members of my free Facebook group the savvy luminary have asked, and then a short what's coming up next with this podcast. So let's dive in. Well, if you've been watching this on video on YouTube, or maybe you hear a slight change in the Echo, I am not recording from my normal space under the stairs in San Francisco. I'm actually spending the summer in Hawaii visiting family and friends. So I'm really grateful to be here. But my summer schedule has been thrown off a little bit, which is fine, because I made a promise to myself to honor, honor summer, in a decolonized way by making more space to do the things that are important to me, and important to my work. So making lots of time for fun and spending with my family, and making time spacious time to do some extra things in my business that I wouldn't normally get to do in the regular part of the year, like finishing up an extra chapter for my star power Brand Book, and doing some inner internal big shifts in the business that I'm gonna give you a little preview at the very end of this episode about what's coming up next. So this summer, I hope that you have been practicing what it means to rest. Jordan Manny had done our new moon ceremony for cancer a few weeks back and she just kind of opened up our minds for the participants in sharing the seven different types of rest. And how the summer is really this important time with cancer season to really claim that rest. Well, also in cancer season, every full moon in cancer season is a Capricorn Full Moon, illuminating all the ways we may be setting up our own boundaries or not setting up our own boundaries, and illuminating all the ways that we have reached for our goals and our accomplishments, and maybe where we still have some gaps. Let's talk about this Capricorn Full Moon in the book that I wrote with Natalie Miller at the beginning of the year new and full moon rituals for entrepreneurs and changemakers. Yes, it is a mouthful. We co wrote a little section where we gave this theme for this Full Moon in Capricorn at 21 degrees. revolutionising your authority. So the full moon at Capricorn of 21 degrees happens exactly at 11:37am Pacific 2:37pm. Eastern on a Wednesday, July 13. And so I'm just gonna read a little bit of what Natalie and I wrote in our book, and we say this Full Moon in Capricorn illuminates where you trust your expertise and

how you take full responsibility for yourself and your work, and also where and how you don't. This lunation may bring up some intense feelings about your power of lack thereof. Along with excellent conditions. We're exploring what those feelings we are revealing to you about your relationship with your own authority. During this full moon, we want you to think of authority as authorship. While we cannot control what happens or what others do and think we you can author the narratives that influence your own perspectives and actions. Saturn, the ruler of this Full Moon from his other home sign of Aquarius asks us to clear up our thinking in ways that enable us to do better. In short, this whole moon asks us to step up take responsibility and be the hero of our own story. On reffing, Uranus together with the North Node is in the mood for revolution. And these energies sextile to the Sun infuses this mood with revolutionary spirit. Sometimes revolution means going back to traditional or ancient ways of doing things. Sometimes it calls us forward with quantum tech advances. Change comes in so many forms and it's perfect moment to choose the ones that empower you most. You know, reading that back to you just to kind of set the space for this podcast episode. It's so interesting that Natalie and I wrote that before the calendar even shifted into 2022. And how, how even more important this message is, especially since this summer, in my program, Star powered summer, we are exploring post colonial astrology, based on the book by our sparkly cat, post colonial astrology really shows us all the ways we are living and breathing and operating in the systems of oppression stemmed from colonialism, you know, all those isms like ableism, racism, sexism, all of those isms are based in the extractive conquering powers of colonialism. Wherever you live in that spectrum of being a settler, like me, I am not Native Hawaiian, but I was born and raised in Hawaii, I am a settler, and I do my best to, you know, be connected to the culture and land here to help the native Hawaiians that live here, or were as my settler in Hawaii. Or maybe, maybe you are one of the original colonists, wherever we are, we are here now. And it's time to really bring awareness instead of just going with the status quo and really upholding these systems that are not all serving us for our highest good or they're doing their damn best to lie to us. Okay, I don't mean to get so political here. But I believe that all of us who choose to work for ourselves as an entrepreneur or business owner, or choose to work for others in a change making field are not okay with how the world and how the systems that we live in breathe in have operated. The systems don't work for most of us. And the systems and we think about, like oppressive systems or systems of institutions or government systems are heart hierarchical systems like corporations and military and even like higher learning, and orchestral music, you can see all of these top down systems that are actually built from colonial models that stem all the way back to the Roman Empire. And all of these systems are, of course, ruled by Saturn, very, very Capricorn. So when we're thinking about just this full moon, and you already know that the full moon is to see things in full illumination, the bright light of the cancer sun shining directly on the face of the Capricorn Moon is illuminating all of those Cancerian Capricorn themes about about responsibility, accountability, belonging, and just kind of the sacred structures that we build in our life and our work. Now, you already know by listening to me for a little while here, and if you're new, one of the things that I love to talk about Saturn is because Saturn can kind of get a really bad rap, especially when we think of it from this like oppressive regime kind of way. But the evolution the change of Saturn and how I would love everybody to embrace Saturn is seeing Saturn as the trellis, a trellis that where you and your work, think of your work as this beautiful jasmine vine. And if you've ever watched Jasmine or lived anyplace where there is Jasmine growing, if Jasmine doesn't have something to climb on onto, it has zero form it has zero shape, it can't even grow. It's just like this flabby little, like little stick of a vine on the ground. But as soon as Jasmine has something to climb on to it reaches for the sun. And if we have built a trellis, then you can shape and you can form this jasmine vine to fit a beautiful wall or fit a part of your landscaping your garden or a part of your house. And it becomes this beautiful structure this beautiful flowering structure with all these fragrant flowers reaching for the sky. Those fragrant flowers reaching for the sky is your

work. And the trellis is your Capricorn. Now that old version of Capricorn are things like, again institutions when I think about institutions, again coming from the classical music world. The end situations would say, Okay, well, if you don't have a degree in music, you can't play in my orchestra, no matter how good you are. And you may or may not know this, but union orchestras, when they are auditioning new people to come into the orchestra, they actually have a blind jury, meaning that the judges that Judah caters are sitting behind a screen where they cannot see the person playing. And this came up because of women were not being allowed to join orchestras, way back when and so they started putting up these blind auditions so that more women more wonderful women players, and more people of color could start joining these orchestras. Now orchestras are still highly problematic in terms of just gatekeeping, and people having access to be able to play these expensive instruments and to get the right education and to be able to afford the time to spend just practicing and playing all kinds of systemic oppression in there. But you can also think of corporations and governments where in an orchestra, you have a conductor, and the conductor is the director. And you can think of this director as that kind of Saturnian old version of Saturnian Capricorn image. The conductor is then, you know, looking at the first violin, and the first violin dictates all of the Boeing's for all of the violins, and then coordinates with the cellos and violas and the basis for extra Boeing's so that all of the Boeing's up and down and up and down are all in unison. Now, I'm a clarinet player. So I'm sitting in the second row behind all these strings. So we have the first flute player, the first oboe player, the first clarinet player, the first bassoon player, the French, first French horn player, and all the way down to the brass is there is a pecking order. Okay, if you're playing second or third clarinet in, in an orchestra, you have no voice, okay? I mean, yes, you have a musical voice, which your job is to follow exactly what the conductor is doing, follow exactly what the first clarinet is, is doing following exactly and blending in with the rest of the orchestra. Just thinking about it sometimes just kind of makes me feel like Ah, just like squishes me, and makes my throat really, really, really tight. Hence why I don't really play into many orchestras. Nowadays, I was starting to really feel stifled. And now I play in a chamber music where there's five of us, it's a small group, it's much more circular lead, where we're all contributing our voice. We're all taking turns leading, there is not a pecking order in chamber music. And the reason why I'm telling you all of this is because when we're thinking about like, what is post institutions and post capital, capital, post capital in our work, if that is something that interests you, because we are we are, I mean, to be honest with where we are in the world, and where we are with capitalistic business structures, it has gone too far, it is unethical for so many corporations to have a few corporations do have so much wealth and so much power, something has to shift. And this is something that we are exploring and star powered summer, I certainly do not have all of the answers. But I know it's not going to be based on this kind of pecking order where there's one person that has ultimate power, and everybody else has to listen to them. And so the reason why I bring this up is because we can think about in our work and in our businesses, how we are still operating in this place of really like hierarchical top down. So centralized kind of power in our work in our businesses. And even if you work for yourselves, how you might be replicating some of these kinds of power dynamics in your life and work. No judgment, right? Because again, these are the systems that we live and breathe in. It's really hard to discern, hey, is this is this truth that has is what has always been, is this still true? Who wrote this? And is this for me? And what can I do to change? Okay, and so, in that full moon write up that Natalie and I are writing, this Capricorn ideal is now about centering your own power into your own authorship. Now, there might be some of us who are not okay with this idea of authority or power, because we might have had people taking power away from us or holding authority over us. So of course, we wouldn't have these good relationships with those kinds of words. But now I'm asking you to really claim your own power and your own authority, your own responsibility with this Capricorn Full Moon. So if you want to take a look back to the last six months when we had our Capricorn New Moon when

you're making all of your goals for the new year, or maybe you want to go back the last, like 18 months to the Capricorn New Moon that was actually on this near this 21 degree of Capricorn, just think about, look back at your journals to your different Capricorn New Moons. Look at and see like, huh, so I accomplish those goals, right? Because Capricorn is very goal oriented, it wants a challenge. It wants to accomplish its goals. It wants all of the credentials. And I'm not saying that higher education and going after your credentials and your ABCs. I'm not saying that, that that is bad. I'm not saying that at all. But what I am saying is that to be an expert and an authority figure in your own work, you do not need all of those things. Okay. In the last podcast episode, I don't know if you remember the conversation that I had with Alan sparkly cap, who wrote this, like phenomenal book, post colonial astrology it is, it is thick and deep with all kinds of historical facts and knowledge. So much research went into this book that I asked them, Hey, do you have a PhD? And research or anthropology or something like that? Because this book is so deep? And they said, No, I'm just I'm really, I'm not, I'm not under educated or I'm not educated. And I wanted to point out to ace and reflect and just kindly reflect that. It doesn't really matter if they have a PhD or not, because they wrote the book. Okay, they are an expert. And so what did you write the book in, because your vast expertise that you've had over years, decades, and all of the different roles and responsibilities and careers and industries that you've been in, you have your unique mix of expertise that makes you an expert in something, and it's the system that we live in? That tells us well, if you're not if you don't have all of your allocates, if you don't have all of these other things, you're not an expert. I was even just chatting with my husband who's on a panel tomorrow for a tech talk. He's the only person on the panel that doesn't have a PhD in mathematical research, and how he's feeling a little bit kind of, I wouldn't say the word ashamed, but a little bit kind of backpedaling. Like, what am I doing here on this panel of all of these people that have these PhDs and I'm like, Dude, seriously, you take their research, their research that they've only done in theory, you take it and you actually implement it into the technology that you build to work in real time you have hands on experience, they maybe have done research and have theorized and like proven some of their theories, but they're not actually working with it and applying it. So of course, you are an expert. And so I wonder where in your work and your life, maybe you don't see your own expertise. Anyway, I know I digress. I'm very, very passionate about this, about this topic, if you haven't noticed, because for so long, I have not felt like I was my own expert. Even though I have a master's degree in music, I still resist talking to myself as a musician. I had been a designer for like over 10 years and resistant and calling myself a designer. It was finally when I went into astrology. I didn't have to study astrology for that long because I knew it was in my bones that I knew that I was an astrologer. And I'm happy to claim astrology as my own expertise and my authority. So ask yourself this, okay, if we're dismantling this idea of Capricorn so that we can fully see it in our lives. Capricorn for changemakers is about dismantling, institutionalized oppression. So no matter what industry you're in, whether it's coaching or you know, selling, I'm thinking of like doTERRA essential oils are kind of like MLM kind of things. You know, those are institutional those pyramid schemes and things like that. Those are just another form of institutionalized oppression. I hate to break it to y'all But how can you dismantle those things? For changemakers? It's also about proclaiming your sacred knows, creating your boundaries so that you can do the things that are going to work for you. And of course, if we work for others, there are certain things that we cannot say no to, especially if you're employed, it's really hard to say no to your employers. But if if you feel that you're always saying no, or you want to say no all the time, instead of saying, happy, yes, maybe that job isn't for you. And if you're have your own business, or you're an entrepreneur, and you have a really hard time saying no to your clients, then maybe those clients aren't right for you. Okay? Another way that Capricorn for changemaking is about designing accountability for your own goals. Meaning you're going after the things that you want, not going after the things that you think your family wants for you or others things that you should go for. What do

you want? What are the goals that you want to climb that hill for those goals that feels so good for you? Of course, Capricorn for change making is not about overworking and overdoing, all from a sense of duty, instead about prioritizing and strategizing for sustainability. Yes, you want to get up to that top of that mountain and you want a challenge. But you're not going to do it all in one night, right without some great strategy and prioritizing, so making sure that you're fully rested and have everything that you need for that long haul. Lastly, Capricorn for change makers is about claiming your own expertise and authority. Just like I was mentioning with my husband, and with Alice, sparkly cats, they are experts, and they are here to claim their own authority in their own unique way. It does not matter if they have a PhD. They have lived experience and proven proven. I was wrote a book. So this Full Moon, I want you to illuminate how you and your work are being held back by the shadows of institutionalized systems, whether this could be sexism, ableism, racism, colonialism, these Capricorn shadows that can show up for you could look like overcommitting, right? Just saying yes, yes, yes, yes, yes. It could show up like doubting your expertise. Like, my husband earlier, I will like let's bring this to me. I earlier said that I had a hard time calling myself a musician, even though I have a master's degree in music. This could also be gatekeeping. Now, maybe, let's you know, take a little bit like a look, are you being the gatekeeper? Okay. Are you preventing somebody from accessing something? Or are the gates being closed on you? Just be honest, you know, no judgments? This is all just about awareness so that we can make better choices going forward? Are you doing things out of obligation? Especially, I noticed, I noticed this a lot for people who go into medicine, sometimes even law, especially when they come from a family of doctors or lawyers that they go into these fields out of sense of obligation, not saying that everyone does this. But notice, are you doing something out of a sense of obligation or duty, and this duty, comes up to upholding out dated rules? Whose rules are there anyway? Right? Have you found yourself caught up in knots? I hate to say whistleblowing but not advocating or standing up to a rule that just does not fit for everyone that is not equitable. Okay. So everything is really illuminated with astrology of this Capricorn Full Moon, we have Venus that is going to be squaring up with Pluto retrograde Exactly. And that is giving us some some integration and some tension with with kind of our partnerships and our power. And then the sun and moon are going to be joining up tomorrow, near tomorrow. Also putting your mind and heart on the same page. That's going to be really nice. Then we also have the full moon approaching Pluto. And this is cool. This can have the potential to be pretty intense, especially when it comes to your intuitive spidey sense. Just really pay attention because nothing is going to hide it And that's a good thing. Okay, thanks to this moon approaching Pluto, trust your intuition because it's going to be revealing things that are going to maybe just like, blow your mind. Lastly, we have Uranus and north node that are getting closer and closer, they're going to be meeting up at the end of the month, but they're already an orb super close to each other. And the moon will be training Uranus and the North Node, which is really giving us that kind of revolution, revolutionary energy awakening you to what really needs to be changed for your highest good. Okay. So I want to then go forth and give you some personalizations just some questions for you to ask yourself based on your rising sign. And then I'm going to go into some questions from the savvy luminary, okay. So if you are a cancer or a Capricorn rising, because remember, the sun and the moon are sitting right opposite each other, so they are activating a pair of houses. And so I'm going to be grouping the oppositional signs together. So if you're a cancer or Capricorn rising, your access of relationships are being activated. And this is asking you to see where you are claiming or giving away your power. Asking yourself like, who is the expert here? Your answer should be you. Not should be you but I hope you know about the answer is you. Now, if you're a Leo or Aquarius rising, this is activating your axis of effectiveness that 12th House sixth house axes, and this is asking you where are you over working out have a sense of obligation? And are you making room to restore Add rest in your own way? Remember, Jordan reminded us that there are seven ways to rest not all rest includes napping and putting

your feet up sometimes rest means going on Iran, whatever rest means for you. But if you are that Leo Aquarius, rising, really look at where and why you are overworking in your in your life. Okay. Now, if you're a Virgo, or Pisces, this is activating the axis of creativity, the fifth and the 11th house. And this one is really about change. Okay, and what needs to change in your life and work? What needs to revolutionize maybe it's social change that needs to happen? Maybe it's change in the way that you treat yourself and your inner child's needs or even your children's needs, right? Where are you replicating oppressive behaviors in your life and work for you Virgo Pisces risings. Okay, now for Libra Aries risings. This is activating your fourth and your 10th house your axes of responsibility. Where are you not facing your sacred knows? Are you really accountable or responsible for this? If you are, make a plan to be accountable, if you're not get those people who are really accountable, it's okay to delegate and it's okay to not even have a reason to say no. Repeat that after me. No. Okay. Now, if you're a Scorpio and Taurus rising, this is activating your access of information that third house axes. And this is asking you, where are you believing in something just because it's always been? Is it true? Like really? Is it true? I think that some of these things that maybe you might be believing in were written by people who didn't want to didn't want to give you your power. So look at what are you believing in? And is it really true? And then for us, Sagittarius and Gemini risings. This is activating and highlighting illuminating our axis of value. Where are you undervaluing your contributions? Are the prices are the pricing is what you're charging is what you're getting paid? Is it equitable? Is what you're paying. Is it equitable? Again, all of these we can look at the oppressions that we are that we are being held under but we can also look at the oppressions that we may inadvertently be passing through in our work. Okay, so take a look at that, and I would love to hear your thoughts. So let's go to Do some questions for my feet free Facebook group, the savvy luminary. And so if you're on Facebook, you can always head on over to the savvy luminary. I'm always pumped. And I'm always asking questions and prompts in there. Just on the fly. It's a super fun place for Astro curious business owners and changemakers to come together. And so Sarah asks, how do we bridge how do we become the bridge and take care of ourselves for all of this hard work? And so I know Sarah's work, she is an advocate for neurodivergent, folks, and she is often being asked to do some Greek pretty hard work in terms of emotional labor and education and standing up. And so yes, Sarah, such a good question for this. Capricorn Full Moon. And right off the bat is making sure that you have super, super clear boundaries. When are you working? And when are you resting, making sure that you are resting and nourishing yourself? That's the cancer sun, the season of nourishing yourself so that you can do the work that is the most important prioritizing the work that are going to accomplish your goals. Instead of all of the 80 bitty little things. For whatever reason, my little kindergarteners son well, he's a he's a rising first grader. But he already learned this. And I was just like, wow, he learned this Stephen Covey process. Already, they learned it in kindergarten, when putting back toys. And I think this is ingenious, because he was helping my husband pack the trunk the other day, where we're like putting all the lug the luggage back in the trunk. My husband put the backpack in the trunk first, and we have all these big suitcases. And my son was like, you have to put the big things in first, so that the little things can fit around it. And i My heart is just was just full of love for my little son. And so Farah, going back to your question, when you're prioritizing and this goes for all of us prioritize doing the biggest, most important things first, and I'm listening to myself talk and I'm like, Oh, yes, I have been making space for all the little details and all the tasks and all the little things that get in the way. So for all of us as we use this Capricorn Full Moon, to really see where we haven't been putting in the big suitcases in the trunk first. So I hope that serves you, Sarah, for Sasha. She's wondering about integrity and system structures for this full moon. And how will it affect us needle Cappy moon? Yes. So the integrity and systems and structures? Yes, I feel like this whole episode really talked about integrity and systems and structures, by really looking at where we have a choice in terms of the systems and structures that we build in our businesses? Are they equitable? Do

they allow for sustainability? Are they based around the things that we are responsible and accountable for? Or if we are working for others? How can we start to dismantle some of these systems and structures that aren't working? Now? Earlier, I was talking about that kind of hierarchical systems. And for some of us that, you know, if we have those privileges, right, I can there's some people who don't have choices. And but I believe that people who are listening to this podcast are privileged people. And then we get to make choices, you can opt out of being part of systems that you don't like, right? Whether this is opting out of ordering things from Amazon, whether this is opting out from paying for a PhD, just because you want to get that PhD to prove that you already know. Or this is me opting out of playing in orchestras, because I just couldn't play in those systems anymore. And so when you're thinking about the illuminating, look at where, in your work, have you built systems that are not in integrity, or you're participating in places that are not in integrity, and for all of those Capricorn moons out there, I know you're out there. We one day when I have my upcoming membership, I'm going to resurrect a membership that I had a few moons back. And 1010s I promise I'm going to have a Capricorn Moon support group, but for the Capricorn moons as the moon moves to kappa Quarren and this is for all of us, when the moon returns to that place of your natal moon, this is called a lunar return. And you get this once every month, right? This is a great time of month. And it is known as a fertile time of, of, of the month. Okay? And so like literally it can be, it can be completely literally where you get pregnant on that kind of lunar return. Or if you're not looking to have a child, maybe this is a fertile time to spark a new project or get some extra creative in your work. And so that should be fun to look at that. But there's a lot of things going on in Capricorn right now. We have Pluto still in Capricorn. So I don't know exactly what degree your Capricorn Moon is that Capricorn moon, they'll be at 21 degrees Pluto, still at 27 degrees. We have Chiron at 16 degrees in Aries and Jupiter eight degrees of Aries. So there's there's a whole wide spectrum of how these Capricorn moons could be experiencing depending on what degree because there's a lot of Cardinal energy going on right now that may or may not be pinging your natal Capricorn moon. So I hope that served. Um, and then Carmen asks, Is this a good time to publish my first web page? If so, when? Or how long? Do I have to complete the publishing of the webpage? So that's an interesting question. Because what I would like to know, when we're thinking about that question, Carmine is kind of an electoral question, you're asking about a good time to put something out in the world thinking about your webpage as having its first graph in the public world. And so depending on what the goal of the outcome of that webpage is, as well as some of your own natal energies, there could be a lot of different answers for publishing your web page. Now, for me, as soon as I have a web page done, I'm like, boom, I'm gonna post it because I don't want to wait for anything like I just have, I just want to get it out into the world. But generally, on a full moon, you may want to wait till after the moon is full, for any kind of election or processes. Generally, a full moon is not a good day to elect to do something unless it's something that you want to sever or cut off. Right? If your web page is making as an opinion piece that you want to polarize people, then yes. But if it's something that you want to bring more people in, or growth of traffic, probably the full moon, would it be the right time, because when we look at the moon, the moon has an opposition to the sun. And generally, when you're electing a time having an opposition of the moon, even though it's the sun isn't necessarily the best energy. But again, I instead of kind of what I want to offer for anybody who's working with Electoral Astrology, is to remember that there is no perfect time that if you are ready, and you are done, then release it into the world with all of its best intentions, and to use and trust your own intuition. Sometimes when we try to micromanage all of the astrological timing, we get into this place of trying to almost like manipulate and enter an outcome. And then we still don't get the outcome that we want. Even though we did all of this like minutia work, it can turn into a big headache. So don't overthink it. If you're done with it, you're happy, release it into the world because you know what, it's a webpage. It's not written in stone, you can always edit things and move forward. So of course,

understanding what is the goal of this webpage would also enable us to answer that question a little bit better. Well, I thought this was going to be a short little episode, but I've been talking now straight for 43 minutes. It's been so lovely to come back and chat with you all. I wanted you to be the first to know that over the course of the next month. I haven't figured out the entire plan. I have some little post some like milestone posts of the changes that I want to have come forward. But the name of this podcast and kind of the breadth of my work. I'm shifting it specifically from just entrepreneurial work and business owners to change makers because I've noticed that a lot of my people or maybe they have a job someplace else, or they don't necessarily identify as entrepreneurs. So I'm making this a more inclusive space for people who identify as changemakers that want to use astrology to lead by their chart. And so this podcast is going to be shifting. And I'll let you know when things change. And I'm in the process of outlining a few introductory episodes about just my philosophy, my my little shift in perspective, but this podcast will soon be called Star powered. And star powered will also be the platform for an upcoming membership that I want to make really accessible to people that this membership will also contain my entire library of trainings, it's going to have so much so many goodies, it's going to have a place for community, it's great to have a place for learning astrology, it's going to be a place where we just all of us astral lovers just come together.
